Application to Undertake Memorial Works

Burial authorities are required by law to protect the public from dangerous memorials by ensuring compliance with current national installation standards. All new installations at Tottenham Park Cemetery and any subsequent renovations, replacements or repairs etc, where applicable, are to be completed to British Standard 8415. No company or individual will be permitted on site to complete such works unless they can provide evidence to support this. Evidence must be provided upon request.

A design of the proposed memorial stating dimensions, should be sketched herein together with the inscription.
